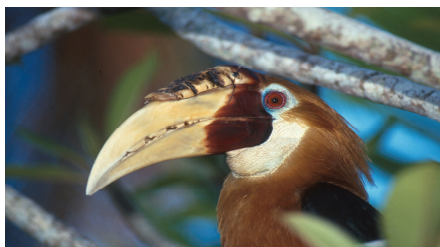
## MADANG RESORT & KALIBOBO VILLAGE

The Madang Resort in PNG with a wide range of facilities to enable you to enjoy your visit to Madang. The twin Resorts are built on 15 landscaped acres of landscaped gardens facing north along absolute water frontages facing Krangkiet Island and the offshore islands of Kar Kar and Bagabag in the distance. The resort has 1 km of absolute water frontage along the entrance to the Madang Harbour and Yamilon Lagoon.

Features include PADI dive facility, marina, tennis court, 4 pools, 2 lagoons, kayak, sailing cats, bikes, car hire, sight-seeing tours & cruises. There are two restaurants and cocktail bars, extensive conference facilities and the new Kalibobo Haus Kibung, a purposely built air

## MADANG, MADANG

Madang is considered to be one of the prettiest towns in the Pacific and the most popular holiday destination in PNG. The township has population of 46,000. Whilst the Province which shares the same name as the Township with a total pop of 450,000 speaking 173 languages and individual cultures. Geographically it boasts the offshore volcanic islands of



Manam, Boisa, Kar Kar, Bagabag, Crown & Long Island. The Madang Lagoon has more than 30 coral laced islands ideal for snorkeling and diving and the coastline stretches from Saidor in the East to Sepik River in the west. Inland of the coast there are 3 large mountain including Mt Wilhelm (15,000'), the highest mountain in PNG on the border of the Simbu Province.. The Ramu River runs through the fertile Ramu Valley along the full length of the Province.



For the adventurous trekking offers a wonderful opportunity to see rare birds including the Lesser & King Birds of Paradise, Victorian Crown Pigeons, Parrots, cockeys, marsupials even tree kangaroos and not least some of the most awesome scenery in the world.

The economy of Madang consists of timber, tourism, fishing, copra, cocoa, sugar, oil palm nickel, copper & gold. You will be made welcome in villages and markets by the people.

Access to Madang is by road from Lae and the Highlands or by Air Niugini and Travel Air who operate three daily services from Port Moresby with additional services to Wewak and Vanimo.

The Resort also offers meeting and conference facilities to cater up to 400 with a business centre, shops, hair salon, WiFi internet available in most public areas.

Combined accommodation consists of 170 suites, 20 cottages and bungalows, all with satellite TV, wireless internet, en-suite, balconies and all have tea/coffee making facilities, some with kitchenettes for longer term guests.





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## CONFERENCES

The Madang Resort is the ideal loca-



tion for conferences, meetings, weddings and special events. The Sana Room can accommodate up to 400 in banquet setting and can be divided into 3 separate rooms. The Nicholay Mikloucho-Maclay room seats 50 and the Tamendek Board Room 25. Each conference room has its own restrooms, all are fully air conditioned and equipped with audio visual with video conferencing available though the optic fibre cable. There is a fully equipped business centre, WiFi internet connectivity. The Kalibobo Haus Kibung is a special function room that can seat 200 overlooking the pool and Madang Lagoon. Other venues for meals and functions include the Haus Win Restaurant, Janek Aben Restaurant, our Marquees at Forum Park on a nearby island or aboard the Kalibobo Spirit.. The Madang Resort has been the chosen venue for major domestic and international conferences including the Suoth Pacific Forum twice.



## KALIBOBO SPIRIT



The Kalibobo Spirit is a 30m luxury motor yacht owned by MTS and based at the Marina at the Madang Resort. The vessel is available for charter for dinner functions, Board Meetings, and overnight exploration cruising in PNG waters including the Sepik River.

There are 10 air conditioned cabins with ensuites, dining and lounge plus adequate covered deck space. The vessel is equipped to handle up to 16 divers and is operated on both Queensland and PNG

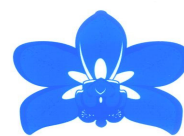
**Dive Costs include** 8 dives half day village tour, buffet breakfast and airport transfers.
